

Managing Electronic Resources in Health Science Libraries

Abstract

This is a four-hour continuing education course intended for health science librarians. It is designed to introduce attendees to the technologies required to provide electronic resources in a health science library. Attendees will become familiar with basic electronic resources and their corresponding technologies, as well as advanced technologies and future trends in health science libraries. Typical technology issues such as licensing, troubleshooting, and remote access will be addressed.

Objectives

Participants will be able to:

- become familiar with basic electronic resources and their corresponding technologies
- identify advanced technologies and future trends in health science libraries
- become familiar with pricing, licensing, access, and other issues of electronic resource management
- learn methods for troubleshooting and resolving electronic resource problems
- identify resources for learning more information about electronic health information resources
