OPTION YEAR 1 (2012-2013) OBJECTIVES**

1. In collaboration with NLM, provide high-quality instructional offerings to health science librarians, public librarians, health professionals, and the public health workforce through a variety of delivery methods. Class offerings include:
  - a. PubMed® for Trainers hybrid class, taught in 4 sessions each (3 one hour Adobe Connect sessions and 1 seven hour in-person session). At least one session per region per year will be offered.
  - b. Online modular Adobe Connect PubMed sessions, taught in one hour increments and customized for different audiences (librarians, health professionals, and the public health workforce).
  - c. TOXNET® and Beyond class, taught as a 6 hour in-person class and as a 1 hour modular Adobe Connect session.
  - d. Self-paced tutorials related to PubMed, TOXNET, and NCBI.
  - e. NCBI online classes in collaboration with NCBI staff and NCBI database experts.
  - f. Teaching with Technology, an 8 hour asynchronous Moodle class covering adult learning principles as well as tools for online teaching.
2. Ensure that all e-learning instructional offerings are 508 compliant.
3. Review current assessment tools with NLM and revise as needed; administer and report results of assessments related to student satisfaction and student knowledge gained.
4. Administer a year-end follow-up assessment to determine if the training improved the efficiency and effectiveness of student's use of the databases.
5. Plan in-person and e-learning schedules in collaboration with NLM by June 30<sup>th</sup> of the contract year

- 6.** Utilize a variety of communication mechanisms, including social networking sites, to promote NTC activities.
- 7.** Promote the MLA Educational Clearinghouse as a resource for NN/LM training offerings to the RML and member libraries.
- 8.** Maintain and update the NTC web site, class schedule and registration system.
- 9.** Maintain and improve the regional class schedule and registration system in collaboration with the RMLs
- 10.** Form an Advisory Group and incorporate suggestions for improvement into the future operation of the NTC.
