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


## NNLM Outreach Activities: Continental USA



- Integrating with the broader institutional data community



# **Biomedical and Health Research Data Management**

**New Training Program for Librarians**

## What is the program?

- A comprehensive, hands-on, engaging training program to boost the readiness of health information professionals to work as key collaborators in the research data lifecycle.

### Course goal

- As a result of this training, the participating cohort will be able to develop or enhance research data management training and services at their institutions.

# About the course

- **8 week online course with engaging lessons and practical activities starting in January 2018**
  - Facilitated by Shirley Zhao, MSLIS, MS
  - Co-taught by experts in the field
  - Participants assigned a mentor for a Capstone project
- **Culminates with a Capstone Summit at NIH**
  - Share Capstone projects
  - Network with experts and cohort
  - Meet NLM leaders in data science
  - Learn about cutting edge NIH data initiatives

# Participants

- Up to 40 participants
- 8 week online class with practical activities and individual feedback
  - Up to 4 hours of work per week
- Expert mentorship in Capstone Project
- Networking with participants and experts in the field
- Travel stipend (\$900) for Capstone Summit NLM (April 10-11 2018)

- **Competitive application**
  - Application on **NTO** page
  - **Due November 8, 2017** notification in December
- **Letter of institutional support**
  - Time for participation in online class and Capstone Summit
  - Willingness to add or enhance data management services
  - Travel expenses not covered by stipend
