



## How PubMed Works: Automatic Term Mapping

1. Automatic Term Mapping (ATM) tries to map your search terms to three translation tables in this order:

2. The Subject Translation Table looks in these nine places to find a match for your search term:

4. The author index contains all author names going back to \_\_\_\_\_.

6. You can search PubMed using a full name to retrieve citations going back to \_\_\_\_\_ . Caveat, not all publishers submit the full name.

7. To find a list indexed phrases in PubMed, use the Advanced Search Builder \_\_\_\_\_ feature.
